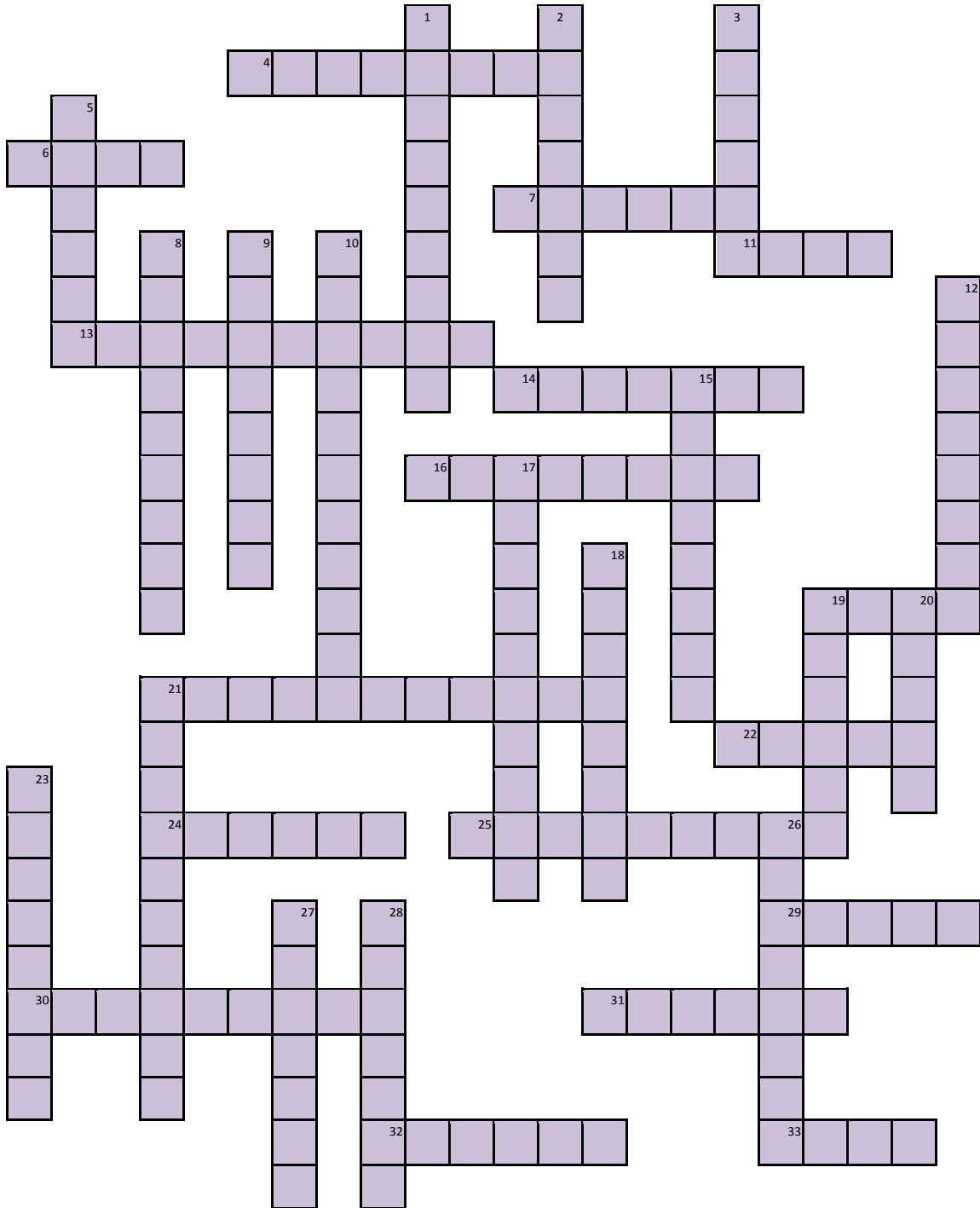


# Mysterious Food
